Why God's Mission through the House Church Ministry?

There should be God's Missional Church at the end of God's Mission.

In the case of Japan, missionaries focused on teaching English and spreading Western culture instead of establishing God's Missional Church. As a result, the fruits of missions in Japan were not strong. However, missionaries who came to Korea focused on establishing God's Missional Church, leading to a great evangelization movement. God's Missional Church with a strong foundation with the Three axes is Needed.

God's Missional Church should be established where Life Bible Study, Small Group, and Corporate Worship are balanced to fulfill the three aspects of Knowledge, Emotion, and Will. Consequently, reproduction through discipleship is essential.

Establishing three generations in God's Missional Church and achieving reproduction through discipleship is pivotal. The House Church Ministry has already formed 3 - 4 generations. This proven model should be implemented in the missional field.

What is the House Church?

Promoting God's Mission through the House Church Ministry

A community where lay leaders gather 6-12 people in homes at least once a week to fulfill the essential functions of the church (worship, education, fellowship, evangelism, and missions).

The House Church biblically shares the responsibilities of church ministry (Ephesians 4:11-12). The senior pastor provides leadership, focusing on prayer and the Word, while equipping lay leaders to undertake pastoral ministry. Lay leaders, through their service in the House Church Ministry, experience the fruits and challenges of the pastor's ministry and develop a genuine sense of partnership by understanding the pastor's heart.

The House Church enables individuals to experience God through honest sharing of life and answers to prayer, transforming their lives. It provides a life where they can practice the teachings they have learned, thereby producing true disciples who live lives consistent with their confession of faith.

The House Church Ministry is a missional community dedicated to saving souls and making disciples, a love community characterized by service and sharing, and an evangelism/mission community reaching out to neighbors and cross-cultural regions.

God's Mission by lay leaders are empowered through the House Church Ministry.

It overcomes the limitation of traditional centralized missions by activating "lay leader-led missions through small groups."

Each House Church supports a missionary. It strengthens the sense of "our missionary" by choosing missionaries known to the group, ensuring sustained motivation and support.

We prioritize prayer support, gathering weekly at our House Church meetings to pray for the missionary and the mission field, integrating sending missions into daily life.

We invite sponsoring missionaries to our House Church, where they share their testimonies, and we personally visit the mission field they support. Through this, we ignite the challenges and passions of missions, providing a platform to discover various opportunities for God's Mission.
